Rep. Darwin Booher Recipient of MTA's Legislator of the Year Award

(Lansing, MI) – The Michigan Township Association (MTA) awarded State Representative Darwin Booher their 2009 Legislator of the Year award at the 56th Annual Educational Conference and Expo at the DeVos Center, in Grand Rapids. Rep. Booher received the award in front of over a thousand township officials, legislators, vendors and guests at the Association's Annual Banquet on Thursday, January 28.

In November 2004, Booher was elected to his first term in the Michigan House to represent residents of the 102nd district (Osceola, Mecosta and Wexford counties). He serves on the House Appropriations Committee.
