Driving Directions

From Detroit area: Take I-75 north to Grayling (exit 254). Travel west on M-72 approximately 40 miles through Kalkaska into Acme. Turn right (north) onto U.S. 31 and drive a half-mile. The resort will be on the east (right) side of the road.

From Lansing area: Take U.S. 127 north, merging onto I-75. Take exit 254 at Grayling and travel west on M-72 approximately 40 miles through Kalkaska into Acme. Turn right (north) onto U.S. 31 and drive a half-mile. The resort will be on the east (right) side of the road.

From southwest Michigan: Take I-94 to U.S. 131. Travel north to M-72 in Kalkaska. Go west on M-72 approximately 15 miles. Go north on U.S. 31 about a half-mile. The resort will be on the east (right) side of the road.

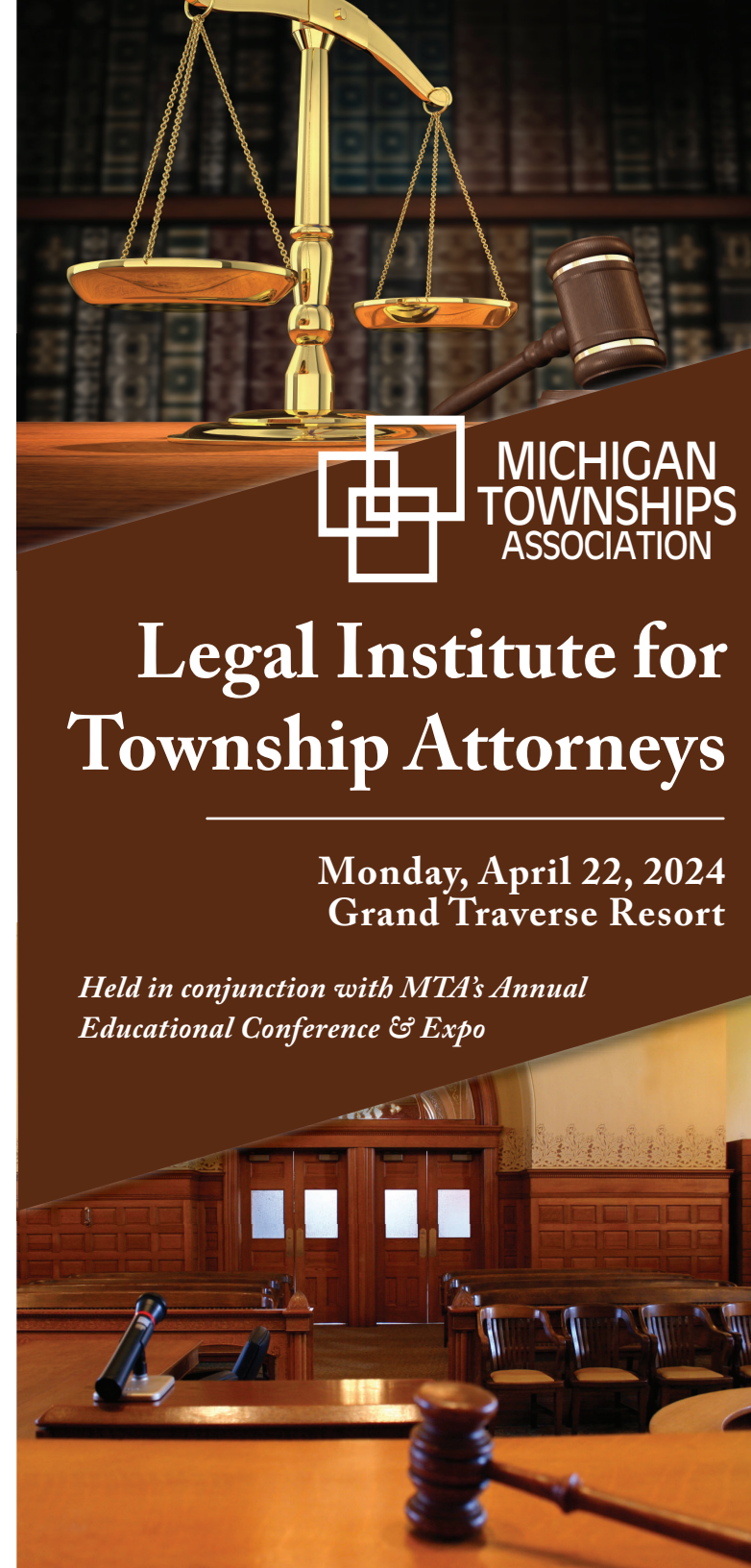
From northern Michigan/the Upper Peninsula: Take I-75 south to the U.S. 31 exit (toward Petoskey/Charlevoix). Continue to follow U.S. 31 south. The resort will be on the east (left) side of the road.

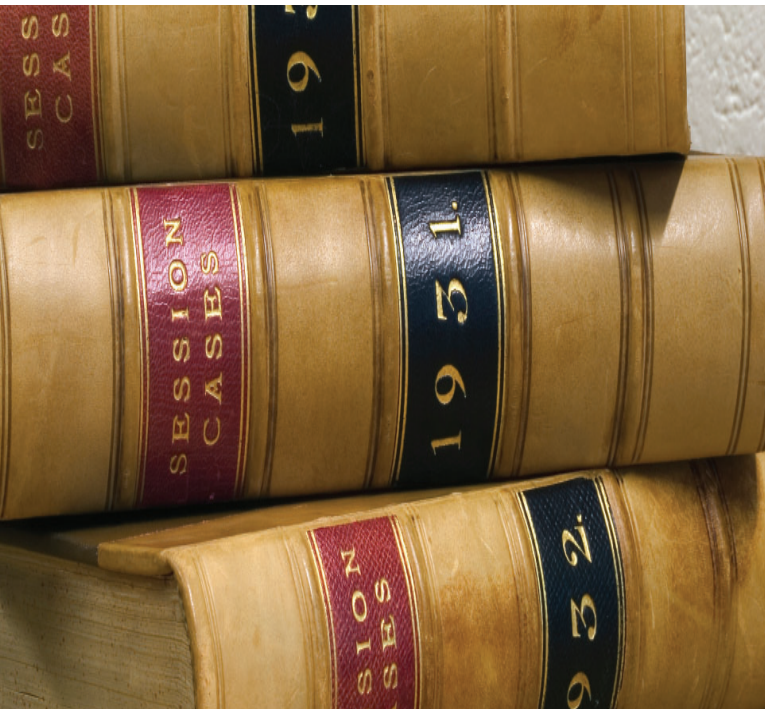
